Fundraising Report: Rhonda Davison said that tickets went out on November 3. Currently, there are 63 students selling tickets. \$330.00 were turned in this AM. Parents are collecting ticket packets in the office, not in the cafeteria. The Pep Rally went smoothly other than the Roller Derby having to cancel their performance the night before. The band and cheerleaders were able to perform. We need more students to sign up to sell tickets. The last day of tickets sell is November 17.

Staff Appreciation: Diane Hawkins reported the the soup luncheon was a success but that not as many parents signed up to volunteer to help. The next staff appreciation will be on November 16, and we will need volunteers to make desserts. On December 22, there will be cookie assortments for staff. In January, we are planning a grab and go breakfast.

Treasurer's Report: Ending October balance is \$13,118.60. We exceeded our \$2400 underwriting goal by \$400. We have sold \$1346.60 in concessions, which is right on target to where we were at last year at this time. We sold all 40 Chick-fil-A sandwiches at a volleyball game, but at the next one, were not able to sell the 40 allotment. We will try this again during basketball season. Rachel Johnston will help to coordinate volunteers for the 7th grade boy basketball team and Nancy Freedle will do this for the 8th grade boys basketball team. We are still looking for 7th and 8th grade girl basketball volunteer coordinators.

Birthday Cookies: The first set of birthday cookies were distributed to students on October 27.

Library Liaison: The book fair is next week.

Dance: The Valentine's Day dance is scheduled for February 16, 2018. The end of school dance is tentatively scheduled for May 18, 2018.

Box Tops: The first contest earned \$135.00 for the school. The next contest will be after the New Year.

Principal's Report: The teachers really enjoyed last week's luncheon. The first incentive after the Pep Rally went very well, and the students seemed to enjoy it. A new wish list item has been requested for the PTO to pay for the buses for the 7th graders spring trip to the Science Mill in Johnson City. This would cost \$2310.00 The PTO will vote in December after the fundraiser is finished in order to see if this can be financed.
